New Skate Canada Skills & Dance Testing

New testing system in effect **September 1, 2017.**

- Enables Skaters to progress at their own rate as skills develop, and be tested during their scheduled ice time.
- A Coach can only assess their own skaters in the discipline(s) they teach: Skills, Freeskate and Dance.
- A Coach is 100% accountable for Skater development.
- Star 1 to 5 is equivalent to the "OLD" judging system of Preliminary and Junior Bronze.
- Skaters that started testing under the "old" system will be given credit under the "new" system to the level that they have completed in each discipline.
- Skaters will be asked to be dressed in proper skating dress or skirt on the day of their test.
- o Cost is \$12 per test
